Ephesians 6:10-18 - Read the passage together

- **What did you think about the teaching on Sunday?**
- Was there something you learned that was new to you, or something about which you were glad to be reminded?
- What was one thing that you sensed the Spirit saying specifically to you?
- (For those who are slow to engage)
 - o What came to mind as we discussed that we live in the “evil day”?
 - o We covered a new kind of praying – confession prayers. How often do you think we need to do this? Why?
 - o What four pieces of the armor have we covered?
 - o Are shoes a big deal for you? Why are shoes a big deal for a soldier?
 - o What word describes the shoes God wants us to put on?
 - o What do you think of when you hear the word “peace”?
 - o What is the good news?
 - o Is there a situation that you feel you would NOT be ready for? Why? How can Jesus give you readiness in that situation and others like it?

Prayer Time (20 min)

- What is the benefit of prayers of confession?
- What concerns or praises can we offer to Him?
- (Please remember that we want to spend time in prayer, not just in sharing prayer requests. If we allow plenty of time, we can have a prayer experience that is not rushed. Growing in comfort level with prayer time will be a process; just take one step at a time! No rush.)
